Sermon Notes

- Sometimes Christians think Pentecost is the Holy Spirit's big introduction, whereas Father, Son, and Holy Spirit have been together since the beginning.
- Pentecost means "the fiftieth day".
- We tend to separate out the Trinity. God the Father was in the Old Testament, then Jesus came in the New Testament, and then he went back to heaven and the Spirit came. Not true.
- The Holy Spirit called together the body of Christ. The disciples gathered and fasted and prayed and waited...and then one day, the Holy Spirit swept into the house.

- Sometimes I've heard it said this way:
 - God the Father is over us—we pray to Him, He created us.
 - Jesus Christ is called Emmanuel, which means God with us. He came to earth and lived among us and called us to follow him.
 - The Holy Spirit is God in us. He dwells within us and acts partly as a compass to help us discern right from wrong. But he also continually convicts, encourages, and transforms us in our lives of faith.
- The Holy Spirit desires to transform us. He wants to burn off those dead vines—those sins we don't want to give up. But he also desires to ignite us—take the offering of our lives and work through us in such a way that produces results we never could have imagined.
