## **Sermon Notes:**

### **Patience**

- How long are people willing to wait?
- We live in an age of 24/7 everything. But we weren't created to go 24/7.
- Jesus carried out his earthly ministry at 3mph...at most.
- How fast are you running...now that things have reopened?
- Dutch Sheets: "We are often into microwaving. God is often into marinating."

### **Background of Passage**

- We aren't simply supposed to "live better" once we accept Jesus as Lord and Savior.
- Paul tells us who we are, and therefore how we should live.
- When we let the peace of Christ rule in our hearts, as Paul urges the Colossians to seek, then we begin to see things through his eyes.

### **For Us Today**

- How do we become more patient people? The question really is...how do we become satisfied in Christ so that we become more patient?
- What do you feel you are lacking in your life...that Christ isn't satisfying?
- The more we can be satisfied in our relationship with Christ, the more our priorities are aligned with his.
