

## Sermon Notes:

### INTRODUCTION

- Last week: looking to God vs. to humans
- This Week: underdog taking on the bully and wearing our own armor



### WHAT IS HAPPENING HERE?

- Decided outcome determined by a contest
- Goliath was about 9'9"
- Israel could find no one worthy
- David begged Saul to let him take on the Philistine. Saul agreed and David used his faith in God and five smooth stones

### THE ARMOR DIDN'T FIT

- **Someone Else's Armor** – When do we give someone what works for us, assuming it will work for him or her?
- **It Didn't Fit!** – Pastor Kevin Sanders – *Saul offered his own armor to David. This was quite an honor, but there was a major problem: David was only a teenage boy, and King Saul was a tall, impressive man. Simply put, Saul's armor didn't fit David. It probably looked like a child trying to wear Dad's shirt.*
- **Using Our Own Gifts** – Pastor Kevin Sanders – *David opted to use the humble weaponry of a shepherd—a staff and a sling. We know what happened from there. God gave David a glorious victory! Why am I talking about Saul's armor? We have a tendency to compare our talents with the talents of others. Sometimes we obsess over the things we can't do instead of improving on the things we can do.*
