BOOK OF EZRA-NEHEMIAH

- Ezra-Nehemiah was originally one book
- About rebuilding Jerusalem after the exile to Babylon
- Nehemiah eventually went there physically, and even took supplies to help them rebuild, but first he sat down, mourned, fasted, wept, prayed

NEHEMIAH'S PRAYER

- Humble
- Consistent
- Honest
- Faithful

FOR US TODAY

- When disaster strikes for us, how do we respond?
- Do we run to God?
- Do we shut Him out and lock Him out of our heart?
- Do we blame God for things we did?
